

Susan's Loopy Flower

This full and showy flower works up to approximately 3 1/2" across when using a medium weight yarn and a size H (5.00 mm) crochet hook, smaller if you use a baby yarn and a size G hook.

Center of Flower:

Rnd 1: Ch 3, join to form small ring. Ch 2, dc 10 times in ring. Join.



Rnd 2: Cover dcs of rnd 1 with 16 long single crochet stitches. (See this helpful [video](#).) Do not join, but continue on in a spiral:



Rnd 3: work (2 sc, sc) around, working in blo (back loops only): 24 sc.(see photo below)



Rnd 4: Reach inward to the remaining loops from rnd 2 and work in them:



*sc in next loop from rnd 2, ch 8, repeat from * around, join: you should have 16 ch-8 loops.



Do not join but continue working in the round:

Rnd 5: *now work more ch-8 loops in the scs from rnd 3:*



work *sc in next sc, ch8, repeat from * around, join: 16 ch-8 loops.



Sew this fashionable flower to the side of your baby hat, near the brim!
